CONSENT ITEMS

MINUTES - Joint Policy Board/TAC Meeting April 13, 2022

BMPO FY 2023 Budget

High Capacity Roadway Study Request for Information

Darrell discussed a few minor changes made in the High-Capacity Roadway Study RFI. The consultant list and participants for the RFI review were discussed. The RFI will be sent to potential candidates May 25th. Submittals from the candidates will be due July 8th.

STBG-U Funding Allocation Status

Darrell discussed talking points for the May 18th ITD Open House.

Children Pedestrian Safety Program

DaNiel discussed the state Children Pedestrian Safety Program. There is \$250,000 available which is 100% funded. Eligible projects include paths/sidewalks along existing roadways, connecting sidewalks/paths between two terminal points, ADA ramps, pedestrian crossing facilities across and existing roadway including signing or signalization, and paving and existing pathway. Applications for the program are due June 8, 2022, projects must be completed by December 2023.
